Who Is Your Authority?

Unless we all agree on the proper authority for our religious teaching, there can never be unity like God commands (I Cor. 1:10). One man proves his doctrine by the writings of the Book of Mormon; another man proves his doctrine by the writings of Watchtower publications, and others by the Catholic Encyclopedia, and still many others by the various creeds written by denominational conventions, synods, councils, etc.

Certainly division is inevitable if we follow the ideas of uninspired men. If you ask man for a reason for their practice (I Peter 3:15), they merely say, "That's what my church manual (discipline, catechism, prayer book, confession) says". If you show by the Scriptures that their doctrine is wrong they reply, "I'll have to ask my preacher (or priest) about that and see what he says." And now days it may be "...what SHE says". Paul wrote to the preacher, Timothy, and said. "But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence" (1 Timothy 2:12).

We must have a common standard of authority. Can you imagine the confusion we would have without a standard in weights and measures or a standard of time. But God is not the author of confusion (I Cor. 14:33), and He didn't start all of the conflicting doctrines of religious sects. He gave all authority, both in heaven and earth, to Christ (Matthew 28:18). We can't even follow the commandments given by Moses, for Christ's law replaced them (Matthew 17:1-5; Colossians 3:14-16), and Moses said that when Christ came we should hear Him in everything (Acts 3:22). In this age, God has spoken through His Son (Hebrews 1:2), and in everything Christ has the preeminence (Col. 1:18; Eph. 1:22,23).

Christ sent the apostles, guided by the Holy Spirit, to teach all things whatsoever He commanded (Matt. 28:20). He gave them a memory of "...whatsoever I have said unto you," and taught them "...all things..." (John 14:26). The spirit guided them into all truth (John 16:13). The apostles taught the doctrine of Christ: "Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God.. ."(2 John 9 --Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God...)

Even if an apostle or an angel from heaven brought us a different teaching. "...let him be accursed" (Gal 1:8). The inspired Scriptures contain all truth, the full Gospel, the perfect law, and everything we need to make us complete (2 Tim 3:16,17; James 1:25).
