The Great Day of Judgment

There is a Judgment Day to which we are all headed. Hebrews 9:27 says, "And it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment." Our appointment for the Day of Judgment cannot be cancelled. The Day of Judgment is certain, inevitable, and no way to escape it. "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad" (2 Corinthians 5:10). There is nothing hidden from the Lord. He knows everything about us. "For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil" (Ecclesiastes 12:14).
